



Cat Fosters:

As a foster care provider for the Humane Society of Iredell (HSI), there are requirements that each foster provider **MUST** follow in order to foster animals for Humane Society of Iredell.

- 1) All foster care providers for Humane Society of Iredell must have volunteer/foster form on file with HSI.
- 2) Foster pets are the sole property of the Humane Society of Iredell.
- 3) Upon request, HSI foster pets will be relinquished to HSI representative.
- 4) ALL foster animals must be kept/housed indoors.
- 5) All pets belonging to foster parents must be spayed/neutered and up to date on all vaccines.
- 6) Foster homes with HSI are not allowed to foster animals for other organizations, per the Executive Director and Board of Directors for HSI.
- 7) In order to comply with animal inventory and medical record keeping, HSI foster pets are not to be re-named by foster caregiver.
- 8) Foster homes and foster caregivers may be limited to the number of foster pets they have in their care, per Executive Director of HSI.
- 9) Foster pets that appear to have ongoing medical concerns within foster homes may be removed from foster home and foster caregiver may be restricted from fostering animals for HSI at the sole discretion of the Executive Director of HSI.
- 10) Efforts must be made to check stock at HSI building first prior to purchasing items for reimbursement. Reimbursement for food and litter is available IF said supplies can not be found at HSI Adoption Center building.

- 11) Foster caregivers are to have foster pets in attendance at every Adoption Fair.
- 12) Foster caregivers do not have the authority as to which cage they can place their cats in unless Cat Room Coordinator gives such permission.
- 13) Foster caregivers who miss two consecutive Adoption Fairs are subject to review by the Executive Director and the Petsmart Cat Coordinator and may face removal from the foster caregiver program.
- 14) Cats that have not been tested for Feline Leukemia or Feline Immunodeficiency Virus are *not allowed* to be present at Petsmart under ANY circumstance.
- 15) The Petsmart Cat Room Coordinator has the authority to request foster cats to be placed in Petsmart cat room.
- 16) Fosters are required to comply with the written *Procedures for Keeping Cats at Petsmart* handout which has or will be provided to the foster caregiver.
- 17) Cats over 6 months of age MUST be spayed or neutered in order to be on display at Petsmart. Kittens are acceptable due to age and weight requirements for spaying and/or neutering.

By signing below, I agree that I will abide by the Humane Society of Iredell's foster rules and policies. Also by signing below I agree that I understand the policies and guidelines, and if I do not abide by the HSI Foster policies and guidelines I may be asked to resign from HSI as a foster caregiver, volunteer, or both.
